Lent lasts 40 days, and this idea can be found in the Bible.

- Jesus fasted for forty days and nights in the wilderness, where he was tempted (Matthew 4:2).
- Also, some other 40 day periods are mentioned in the Bible as well.
- The great flood lasted forty days and nights (Genesis 7:4).
- Moses spent on Mount Sinai forty days and nights (Exodus 24:18).
- The prophet Elijah forty days and forty nights, went up to the hill of God at Horeb (1 Corinthians 19: 8).
- The exploration of the promised land lasted forty days (Numbers 14:34).
- Also, the number 40 most often expresses the age of one generation.
- The Hebrew people wandered in the desert for forty years while traveling to the Promised Land (Numbers 14:34).
- Forty years of the reign of David (2 Samuel 5:4).
